



Standardised Price List July 2025

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this price list for a standardized set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL – (Funeral director’s charges only)	£1895.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£505
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral directors premises) into the funeral directors care.	£250
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities, including dressing in accordance with your instructions. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral directors premises.	£250
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be a Simple Oak Veneered, Fully lined with fittings	£350
Viewing of the deceased person for the family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer) office hours only.	No Charge
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director’s premises) in a hearse, inclusive of Pall Bearers.	£540

UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a separate ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director charges only)	£1,000
Cremation (funeral director charges including cremation fee)	£1,500

FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an attended or unattended burial fee*	£1092-£1350
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for the local residents is:
